S&P SELECTED TO CONSTRUCT NEW PARK & RIDE IN LEAGUE CITY

HOUSTON, TEXAS (March 7, 2011) – Gulf Coast Center MHMR Connect Transit selected Satterfield & Pontikes Construction, Inc. (S&P) to build a new park and ride facility at the University of Texas Medical Branch Victory Lakes campus along Interstate 45 in League City, Texas. The project consists of a 1,872-square-foot terminal building, parking lot, roadway and left turn lane construction, utilities installation, and TxDOT driveway approach.

Architectural and design services for the \$4.2 million project will be provided by PGAL. Management support will be provided by the Goodman Corporation and the Office of Facilities Planning & Construction (OFPC) for the University of Texas at Galveston Medical Branch. The project will begin this month and will take approximately six months to complete.

Providing commuter bus service between League City and Galveston, the Park & Ride facility at Victory Lakes will serve UTMB employees and patients and will be open to everyone on the Island and mainland. The facility will accommodate approximately 450 cars.

Additional project work consists of earthwork, signage, fencing, sanitary and storm sewer systems, landscaping, and parking lot lighting as well as construction of a 16-inch waterline and a 44-foot-wide commercial driveway.

S&P was selected on best value criteria of qualifications, personnel, references, DBE utilization, and financial capacity. Funded in part by the federal government, S&P will coordinate multiple state and local agencies.
