**WALMART SELECTS S&P TO CONSTRUCT NEW MIDWEST CITY MARKET**

**DALLAS, TEXAS** (April 25, 2011) – The Dallas Business Unit of Satterfield & Pontikes Construction, Inc. (S&P) was selected to build a Walmart Market in Midwest City, Oklahoma. Project work has begun on the new 34,983-square-foot Market that will give residents more options for grocery shopping and offer a different inventory than Midwest City’s other grocery retailers.

S&P will build the facility, with structural steel frame, masonry/CMU walls, and concrete flooring, on a 5.33-acre site previously occupied by grocery retailer Albertsons. S&P razed the old Albertson's building at E. Reno Avenue and N. Midwest Boulevard to make room for the new Market.

Construction work is proceeding at a brisk pace under a tight schedule, with the facility scheduled to open this fall. S&P will manage approximately 15 subcontractor firms for the project, many of which are local to the Midwest City area.

The project includes many environmentally friendly and energy-conscious components, including a recycled construction waste goal of 50 percent and recycling the old asphalt parking lot to use as a base for the new parking area. In addition, the storm water pollution prevention plan implemented on this project exceeds current Environmental Protection Agency requirements.

The new \$3,500,000 Walmart Market project in Midwest City represents S&P’s first construction work in Oklahoma and is S&P’s first Walmart Market project. S&P has constructed numerous Walmart Supercenters in Texas and has become one of Walmart’s most reliable builders and a contractor of choice.
