**SATTERFIELD & PONTIKES CONSTRUCTION WINS CONTRACT
FOR NAVAL AIR STATION PROJECT IN PENSACOLA, FLORIDA**

S&P to construct \$22.5 Million LEED Silver Combat Systems Officer Housing

HOUSTON - April 30, 2010 – The Department of the Navy awarded a \$22.5 million contract to **Satterfield & Pontikes Construction, Inc. (S&P)** for the design and construction of an officer housing complex at the Naval Air Station in Pensacola, Florida. The 202-room BRAC Combat Systems Officer Bachelor Housing will be designed and built to LEED Silver standards.

The contract award was made under the best value source selection procedures of the Naval Facilities Engineering Command Southeast, with S&P earning the top spot among 21 bidders for the project. Work will begin immediately, and estimated completion is approximately June 2012.

S&P will lead the design-build team and oversee construction management while KSQ Architects lends support to Huitt-Zollars for project design. This project is unique among housing facilities at the Naval Air Station not only due to the LEED environmental requirements but also because of numerous quality amenities to be installed.

This contract for the Pensacola Naval Air Station is the first S&P job with the U.S. Navy as S&P continues to expand its experience building military housing. Among the many other S&P federal jobs are military medical, housing, and training facilities for the U.S. Army at Fort Sam Houston and the U.S. Air Force at Lackland AFB in San Antonio, Texas, as well as NASA's LEED Office Facility for Transition at the Johnson Space Center in Houston, Texas.
