PORT COMMISSION SELECTS S&P FOR BAYPORT TERMINAL GATE PROJECT

HOUSTON, TEXAS (May 9, 2011) – The Port of Houston Authority awarded a \$33.2 million construction contract to Satterfield & Pontikes Construction, Inc. (S&P) for the Phase 3 entry and exit gate expansion project at the Bayport Terminal in Pasadena. Of the six competitive sealed proposals received by the Port Authority, S&P's proposal was determined to offer the best value.

The project for new construction and structural renovation will provide support buildings, canopies, 20 permanent inbound lanes, and associated infrastructure to support operations of the container terminal. The improved Bayport facilities also will include cutting-edge technology with fiber-optic communication systems for all areas and a Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC) verification and security canopy. In addition, S&P will install more than 98,000 square yards of Roller Compacted Concrete and Portland Cement Concrete.

Design and architectural services are provided by Klotz Associates. The project is scheduled for completion in early 2013.

S&P recently completed a \$22-million project at the Bayport Container Terminal that included construction of a new 35,000-square-foot administration building and 65,500-square-foot maintenance and repair building. Both buildings were designed and built to achieve Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) certification and include many energy-efficient and environmentally friendly components.
