S&P SELECTED TO PROVIDE UPGRADES TO SPRING FOREST MIDDLE SCHOOL

HOUSTON, TEXAS (May 18, 2011) – Spring Branch Independent School District (SBISD) selected Satterfield & Pontikes Construction, Inc. (S&P) to perform significant renovations and upgrades at Spring Forest Middle School in west Houston. Most systems in the 167,000-square-foot school, including electrical, heating, cooling and plumbing will be replaced or upgraded.

Constructed in 1968, Spring Forest Middle School was in need of many repairs and upgrades throughout the facility. The \$9,142,000 renovation project, which is part of SBISD's voter-approved 2007 Bond Plan, encompasses extensive site work and renovations, as well as repair and upgrades of foundations, masonry, drywall, and finishes.

Other project components include concrete and cement work, interior and exterior painting, auditorium seating, and stage equipment. Site restoration work will include pavement, esplanades, sidewalks, driveways, fences, and landscaping. In addition, S&P will install communications, fire alarm and smoke detection, fire extinguishers, intrusion detection and access control systems.

Design and architecture services are provided by Pfluger Associates Architects. The project is scheduled to be completed in August 2012. Work will take place primarily during the summer months of 2011 and 2012 when students are not at school.
