**S&P DELIVERS SIGNIFICANT EXPANSION TO TWU SCIENCE FACILITIES**

**DALLAS, TEXAS** (June 6, 2011) – The Dallas Business Unit of Satterfield & Pontikes Construction, Inc. (S&P) recently completed a two-phase project at Texas Woman’s University in Denton to renovate the existing science building and construct a new addition to the facility. The \$22.5 million project included many environmentally “green” components and energy-saving features which contribute to the university’s goal to reduce its carbon footprint.

The project’s first phase encompassed construction of a 32,000-square-foot addition to provide more labs, classrooms, prep rooms, and offices. In addition, S&P constructed a three-story, glass-walled atrium that connects the new wing to the existing science building.

The second phase provided for a 40,000-square-foot renovation of the existing science building that was built in 1936. After demolition that left only the outside walls and concrete structure, project work included an entire exterior restoration, new windows, doors, roof, ADA upgrades, and asbestos abatement.

The project site was located in the middle of campus with very limited site access. All project work was performed without disruption to campus facilities during the academic year.

Environmentally friendly features include low-VOC paint and other low-emission materials, recycled construction waste, automated lighting with dimmers, and building materials with recycled content. Perkins+Will provided design and architectural services for the project.
