S&P PROJECT WINS AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING MASONRY CONSTRUCTION

SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS (July 5, 2011) – At the San Antonio Masonry Contractors Association’s annual Golden Trowel Awards presentation recently, Cibolo Green Elementary School, built by Satterfield & Pontikes Construction, Inc.’s (S&P) San Antonio Business Unit, received the 1st place award in the K-12 Education category for exceptional masonry work.

The Golden Trowel Award is the highest honor awarded by the association. This is the second consecutive year that an S&P project has won this award.

The masonry work for Cibolo Green Elementary, provided by DJM Masonry, won 1st place in the Educational Facility–Publicly Funded K-12 category. Architectural and design services for the project were provided by Pfluger Architects.

Earlier this month, Cibolo Green Elementary was awarded the City of San Antonio 2011 Green Building Award for the best school construction project. In addition, the school won the Award of Excellence for K-12 Education in Texas Construction’s Best of 2010 competition.

Cibolo Green Elementary School is one of the most impressive construction projects in the San Antonio region, having also received Gold certification through the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) program. Cibolo Green is the first LEED Gold-certified school for North East Independent School District and is a remarkable example of energy efficiency and eco-friendly construction.

In 2010, Satterfield & Pontikes projects won both Golden Trowel honors in the K-12 category. Northside ISD’s Scarborough Elementary School received the 1st place award for its outstanding masonry work, while Judson ISD’s Kirby Middle School took Honorable Mention honors.
