Designed by architects BLGY, Inc., the 196,000-square-foot construction and remodeling project features state-of-the-art technology throughout the school. Unique high-tech features include smartboards in all classrooms that allow interactive student participation through computers.

Several new facilities will be shared by junior and senior high school students, including the auditorium, kitchen/cafeteria, and practice gymnasium. The 800-seat auditorium features two stories of catwalks and professional-quality stage lighting, hidden ceiling lights, advanced audio/visual technology, and sound-deadening acoustical wall panels. The \$1 million kitchen provides a large walk-in cooler/freezer and the latest in modern stainless steel appliances.

The existing 20-year-old intermediate school received substantial remodeling of classrooms and administration area, an addition with new science labs, and revamped technology infrastructure. The campus features a unique moveable mechanical central plant built on a prefabricated skid.

Other new amenities include an athletic facility, football locker room, band hall with soundproof practice rooms, mini black box theatre, and new labs with high-end millwork finishes for chemistry, earth science, physics, and biology. The new facility will be ready for students when classes open for the 2010-2011 school year.
