S&P COMPLETES MODERNIZATION OF KENNEDY-CURRY MIDDLE SCHOOL

DALLAS, TEXAS (August 23, 2011) – The Dallas Business Unit of Satterfield & Pontikes Construction, Inc. (S&P) recently completed work for the Dallas Independent School District to renovate and expand Kennedy-Curry Middle School in south Dallas. Part of Phase I of the District’s 2008 bond program, the school received a total makeover as well as the addition of new space and upgraded facilities.

The total renovation and modernization of the school’s three wings included extensive interior demolition and replacement of ceilings, flooring, windows, lighting and roof. S&P also constructed a 52,000-square-foot addition with cafeteria expansion, new auditorium and library that will link the existing wings and gymnasium.

The 130,000-square-foot project required demolition of Bishop Heights Elementary School and several other buildings. Project work also included new geothermal HVAC systems for both new and existing buildings, new fire alarm and security systems, site parking, service yard, fencing and landscaping, and construction of tennis courts and football, baseball and softball fields. More than 500 geothermal wells will facilitate heating and cooling.

PBK Architects provided design and architectural services for the \$17.8 million project. AECOM served as program manager. S&P used Building Information Modeling to create structural and architectural models and to coordinate above-ceiling components. The project was completed in 15 months and will be open this month for the start of fall semester classes.
