**U.S. ARMY SELECTS SATTERFIELD & PONTIKES CONSTRUCTION
TO BUILD NEW TRAINING CENTER AT THE WOODLANDS**

HOUSTON – September 22, 2010 – The Louisville District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers awarded a \$14.1 million contract to **Satterfield & Pontikes Construction, Inc.** (S&P) to build the new Army Reserve Center (ARC) in The Woodlands, Texas. Work is expected to begin this month and should be completed in early summer 2012.

S&P was rated highest of the 17 firms competing for the USARC design/bid/build project. The project is a LEED for New Construction v2.2 effort and includes many ‘green’ elements, including site sustainability, water efficiency, energy and atmosphere, materials and resources, and indoor environmental quality.

Primary facilities include construction of an ARC training building, Organizational Maintenance Shop, unheated storage building, and organizational parking. Supporting facilities include land clearing, paving, fencing, general site improvements, and extension of utilities to serve the project. Physical security measures, including Anti-Terrorism/Force Protection measures, will be incorporated into design.

The ARC training center building is the centerpiece of the 82,992-square-foot project. Buildings will be constructed of reinforced concrete foundations, concrete floor slabs, structural steel frames, masonry veneer walls, and standing seam metal roof and will provide state-of-the-art training facilities for Army reserves from Houston and the surrounding area.

This contract for the Army Reserve Center further extends S&P’s experience in building military facilities. Among the many other S&P federal jobs are military medical, housing, and training facilities at Fort Sam Houston, Lackland Air Force Base, and the Pensacola Naval Air Station.
