S&P COMPLETES CONSTRUCTION OF WALMART NEIGHBORHOOD MARKET

DALLAS, TEXAS (September 27, 2011) – The Dallas Business Unit of Satterfield & Pontikes Construction, Inc. (S&P) recently completed construction of a new Walmart Neighborhood Market in Midwest City, Oklahoma. Numerous area citizens and dignitaries attended last week’s grand opening ceremonies, including the Midwest City mayor and other government representatives. The 35,000-square-foot Neighborhood Market will be open 24 hours a day to provide residents with more options for grocery shopping and offer a different inventory than Midwest City’s other grocery retailers.

S&P built the Neighborhood Market on a 5.33-acre site previously occupied by grocery retailer Albertsons. S&P razed the old Albertson's building at E. Reno Avenue and N. Midwest Boulevard to make room for the new store. Construction work proceeded at a brisk pace under a tight schedule and was completed in only six months. The successful working relationship between Midwest City, the community, Walmart and S&P ensured that the project was completed on time and within budget.

The new \$3,500,000 Neighborhood Market project in Midwest City represents S&P’s first construction work in Oklahoma and is S&P’s first Neighborhood Market project. The new store includes many environmentally friendly and energy-conscious features, including recycling at least 50 percent of the construction waste and recycling the old asphalt parking lot to use as a base for the new parking area.

S&P has secured no fewer than 12 Walmart projects totaling nearly \$95 million during 2011. S&P has constructed numerous Walmart Supercenters in Texas and has become one of Walmart’s most reliable builders and a contractor of choice.
