**U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS AWARDS CONTRACT TO
SATTERFIELD & PONTIKES FOR HARPERS FERRY PROJECT**

SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS (October 14, 2010) – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Fort Worth District has awarded a contract to the Federal Services Division of Satterfield & Pontikes Construction, Inc. (S&P) in San Antonio to build new facilities at the U.S. Customs and Border Protection’s (CBP) Advanced Training Center at Harpers Ferry, West Virginia.

Facilities to be constructed by S&P include a 24,767-square-foot dining facility, an 8,072 SF welcome/security command center and a 6,321 SF shower/locker room facility. Construction of the \$15,354,000 project should be complete in early 2012.

Part of the Department of Homeland Security, the Advanced Training Center provides advanced firearms and tactical training primarily to CBP’s 40,000 agents, but also trains law enforcement personnel from other federal agencies.

The new training center contract represents Satterfield & Pontikes’ first project in the “Mountain State” and is another strong example of S&P’s expanding capabilities. S&P’s experience in building military facilities includes numerous facilities in Texas, to include: Houston, San Marcos, and at Fort Sam Houston and Lackland Air Force Base in San Antonio, as well as projects at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas and the Naval Air Station in Pensacola, Florida.
