**CY-FAIR ISD HOSTS CEREMONIES FOR COMPLETION OF
JERSEY VILLAGE HIGH SCHOOL MASSIVE RENOVATION PROJECT**

HOUSTON, TEXAS (October 19, 2010) – To celebrate completion of the three-year renovation of Jersey Village High School (JVHS) performed by Satterfield & Pontikes Construction (S&P), Cypress-Fairbanks Independent School District held its ‘View the Village’ event on Saturday, October 16. Guided tours were held for the community and general public along with a ceremony recognizing S&P, Bay Architects and others involved in the renovation project.

“The architects and contractors have done a remarkable job in transforming our school into one which will enable the staff to equip our students with the knowledge and skills necessary for the 21st century,” said Jersey Village principal Ralph Funk. “The design provides us with flexibility and opportunities to further develop our small learning communities concept.”

The JVHS project included the addition of 128,000 square feet of new space and more than 369,000 square feet of renovations and remodeling. S&P used Building Information Modeling to schedule work in phases to minimize disruption to faculty, staff and students. With students on campus continually throughout the project’s entire duration, excellent communication and coordination were required to maintain student separation from work areas and ensure safety.

S&P Assistant Superintendent and Jersey Village High School graduate Kyle Louderback notes that, while attending JVHS, students, teachers and staff often described the school as dark, narrow and windowless. “After the renovation, I see the school in a new light. With wider corridors, updated finishes and additional natural lighting, the school is a far cry from its former self,” stated Louderback. “Through these changes and the incorporation of today’s technologies, the school has been transformed into something that is not only aesthetically pleasing, but which provides students and teachers with the means to be successful.”

S&P’s work at JVHS is part of a \$159.7 million, four-campus project to provide new classrooms, libraries, science labs, and art and music areas. Upgrades also included new ceilings, lights, walls, mechanical, electrical, plumbing and fire-prevention systems.
