S&P WORLD WAR II MUSEUM PROJECT WINS PCI 2011 DESIGN AWARD

NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA (November 2, 2011) – The Precast/Prestressed Concrete Institute (PCI) recently announced winners of its 2011 Design Awards, and Satterfield & Pontikes Construction's (S&P) National World War II Museum Phase IV Expansion project took top honors in the Public/Institutional category. The museum expansion project in New Orleans, La. is in elite company among only 29 winners selected nationwide in buildings and transportation categories.

The 49th Annual PCI Design Awards program recognized design excellence and construction quality using precast concrete. The two-story, 75,000-square-foot World War II museum project showcases the ability of precast concrete to be formed into different shapes, angles and sizes. Components included 221 pieces of precast concrete covering more than 29,000 square feet. Typical height of panels was nearly 8 feet, with lengths ranging from 30 to 50 feet.

One side of the museum consists of large precast concrete panels with angular edges and joints. On other facades, the wall panels lean in and out at varying angles. On one elevation, panels lean at 84 degrees and gradually lean out even more near the top of the building. On another elevation, the panels are set at 90 degrees, but angle out near the top. Some precast panels, representing the cliffs of Normandy, are on the building interior.
