**S&P COMPLETES WORK ON REEVES COUNTY DETENTION FACILITY**

**DALLAS, TEXAS** (November 15, 2010) – Satterfield & Pontikes Construction, Inc. (S&P) recently completely an extensive \$37.5 million construction and renovation project of 29 buildings at the Reeves County Detention Center in Pecos, Texas. The work was required due to inmate rioting and setting fires prison-wide in early 2009, which resulted in damage to almost every building in the low-security facility.

S&P's Dallas Business Unit led the construction and renovation effort that upgraded virtually every structure during work on the 138,000-square-foot project. Several burned buildings required complete demolition and rebuild. The largest building constructed by S&P during the project is the 384-bed inmate dormitory.

In addition, S&P implemented massive site modifications, which included elimination of overhead power lines that were then installed underground. Additional fencing was installed and existing fencing was modified to increase security and provide additional separation of areas.

LMD Architects provided design services for the project. Working with architect Lorraine Dailey, the S&P team began work on the facility in mid-2009.

The remote location and relatively small size of Pecos presented challenges regarding availability of workers and subcontractors. Much of the work force had to come from much larger cities in the region, including Midland, Odessa, and Lubbock.
