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**S&P Tops Out at Texas A&M Health Science Center**

Satterfield & Pontikes Construction, Inc. (S&P) marked a major milestone with a “Topping Out” ceremony at Texas A&M’s new Health Science Center in Bryan, TX. Over 100 people attended the August 24<sup>th</sup> celebration marking the placement of the last piece of structural steel on the HSC’s first two buildings at the College’s brand new Bryan campus.

Totaling over 250,000 square feet, the Health Professions Building and the Medical Research and Education Building are the first two structures on a site planned to eventually have over 4 million square feet of education, research, clinical, and hospital space. Also included in the project is a 27,000 square foot Simulation Center, a 4,100 square foot BSL3 Laboratory, and 12, 565 square foot Central Utility Plant. S&P’s President George A. Pontikes, Jr. remarked, “This is a very special project to us. HSC has ambitious plans, FKP has developed a terrific design, and we are proud to part of that team. Marking the point when the structure is complete is a tremendous milestone.”
